



FREE MAMMOGRAM PROGRAM

Qualification & Eligibility Guidelines

Screening mammograms are approved on a first-come, first-served basis. Patients must meet all criteria to receive a reference number to schedule a mammogram.

Criteria:

- ☐ **Resident of Louisiana**
- ☐ **Uninsured/Under-insured**
- ☐ **Make less than Annual Income Max***
*Must provide verification/pay stubs
- ☐ **Must be (at least one):**
 - Between 40-64 years old;**
 - And/Or Have existing health issues related to breast health;**
 - And/Or Have a family history of breast cancer (mother/sister/daughter/grandmother)**

Income Eligibility Guidelines

Maximum income based on 250% of 2025 Federal Poverty Guidelines
